Objective:

On successful completion of the course the Estate Officers, Administration Officers, Safety/Security Officers and all those concerned with Safety & Security of High Rise Buildings will be in a position to re-organize their Safety and Security plan more efficiently and deal with threats from manmade & natural disasters, such as Fire, Flood, Terrorist's acts or Earthquakes etc, in much efficient manner.

Introduction:

The National Capital Region of Delhi has more than 2000 multi storied buildings housing Offices, Shopping Malls, Residential Complexes, Hospitals, Recreational & Educational Institutions and so on. However, in the recent times, a number of accidents causing loss of precious lives and property have been happening in many of these buildings and every time it is found that the accident could have been avoided "if only there was a trained person in charge of Safety and Security, and the residents warned of preventive measures taken in time...".

The IISSM therefore, aims to address this important issue on Environment Health & Safety (EHS) of High Rise Building through its newly structured course in line with the guide lines contained in Part IV of the National Building Code – 2005 of the Bureau of Indian Standard.

Course Contents:

The three days especially designed and customized course to address the High Rise Building Safety Management comprises of Risks Assessment, Peculiarities of a High Rise Buildings, Fire Prevention & Safety Management, Earthquake – a perpetual phenomena in and

around the NCR, IED & Bomb threat handling techniques and Evacuation drill in a High Rise Building as per the National Building Code – 2005 procedure.

The course is most suitable for all Estate Officers, Administrative Officers, Safety/Security officers and those concerned with Safety & Security of High Rise Buildings which are highly vulnerable & prone to threats from manmade & Natural disasters. The course is also useful for Facility Managers, Building Security Training Managers, Security In-Charges, HR & Finance Managers who deal with Security contracts, Insurance Companies, Civil Contractors, Estate Developers and Builders.
